

Community Grants Terms & Conditions

1. Submitting an application for this grant or submitting a vote constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Southern Cross Credit Union ABN 82 087 650 682 AFSL/Australian credit licence 241000, 38-42 Pearl Street, Kingscliff NSW 2487 is the promoter of this grant.
3. There is a limit of one grant application on behalf of one community group during the Application Period (see point 5). If multiple applications are received for one community group, the group will be eligible for public voting once only. Individuals may only apply on behalf of one community group. If individuals apply for more than one community group, the first application received will only be eligible.
4. Applications for Community Grants open 9am on Monday 3 July 2017 and close at 5pm on Friday 11 August 2017 ("Application Period"). Application approvals will take place from at Southern Cross Credit Union Limited, 38-42 Pearl Street Kingscliff NSW 2487. Winners will be notified by telephone on Friday 17 November 2017. SCCU's decision on all matters relating to the prize draw is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
5. Each of the top three community groups with the most public votes and that best meet the judging criteria will receive a \$5,000 grant.
6. In the instance where less than three applications are received, public voting will still commence for the community groups that have submitted an application.
7. The winner(s) will be notified in writing within two days of the Draw Date via their nominated email address. The winner(s) details will also be published online at sccu.com.au within one week of the Draw Date.
8. Southern Cross Credit Union will contact the entrant once the winner(s) has been determined to request an invoice for the amount of \$5,000. The entrant is required to submit an invoice to Southern Cross Credit Union and funds will be deposited into the community group's bank account within two weeks upon receiving the invoice. Note: payments will only be paid into a bank account in the community group's name.
9. Winner(s) claim their prize in the manner set out in the email informing them that they have won.
10. If the grant remains unclaimed by failing to send an invoice for payment within three months of receiving the email informing them they have won, the grant will be void.
11. The Grant Recipient is required to coordinate with Southern Cross Credit Union on any planned media releases, promotion materials or events and may not undertake any advertising, media engagements or promotions which expressly mention the Community Grant or Southern Cross Credit Union as Grantor without Southern Cross Credit Union's written permission as to content and forum in advance.
12. The organisation that receives the grant must not make a profit that benefits an individual.
13. Southern Cross Credit Union has the ability to change the voting dates.
14. Southern Cross Credit Union is not liable for any losses, injury or damage that may occur directly or indirectly from the use of this grant.
15. No correspondence will be entered into. The promoter's decision is final.
